1. ONLINE GUEST LECTURE -KNOW YOUR HEROES

An online session on the theme 'Know Your Heroes' was organised by APS Gwalior on 14 December 2020 at 0900 Hrs. The objective was to make the students aware about the super heroes who have dedicated their lives for the security of the motherland. The resource person of the session was Capt. Sachin from 18 Mahar. He was zealous interacting with young adults of Class XI. He held open dialogue with the students followed by sharing inside stories of bravery, courage and passion of great indian war heroes. Overall the webinar was very interesting and informative to deal with the CwSN inclusively and helpful for making teaching learning process more effective or in meeting the needs of students in an inclusive classroom.

After the felicitation programme the chief guest interacted with all the parents and presented before them the vision of the school for the new academic session. He briefed the parents about the creation and designing of a new IT enabled conference room in the school campus for promoting online International student exchange programmes, seminars, webinars etc for interactive learning .He also apprised the parents about the introduction of vocational learning model for the students of class VI to VIII where training of carpentry ,cooking ,fabrication along with landscaping ,sculpting and electrical training would be given to the students .These skills have been advocated in the New Education Policy also. Hence the students would get a new kind of exposure in the new academic session.

The school has also planned to start outdoor learning models in Science and Maths by redesigning the Science Park. Decongestion of strength is another concern of the school management hence new classrooms would be constructed for the new admissions of next session. Strength of each class would be restricted to 40 students hence ensuring better learning –teaching environment inside the classrooms .The Chairman of the school, Brig.Sushim Biswas, Cdr 72 Inf Bde also updated the parents about merging of primary wing into the main building .The newly constructed classrooms would accommodate the students of primary wing during the new academic session.The parents were contented with the new vision projected by the chairman of the school.

The Principal of the school ,Mr Arvind Kumar Sikarwar, sensitised all the parents regarding the requirement of offline classes and practical practice for X and XII std

students who would be appearing for Board Examination 2020-21. The suggestions given by the parents regarding safety protocols related to opening of school for conducting physical classes for class X and XII std students were recorded at the orientation. Most of agreed on the requirement of in -person classes for Board appearing the parents students. The Principal assured all the parents about the proper disinfection of school property before the arrival of the students and after the departure of the students . All necessary precautions and measures would be taken by the school management to ensure the safety of the staff and students during this pandemic. Advisory to be followed when the school would reopen was also distributed amongst all the parents. But he also requested all the parents to brief their children about following COVID -19 protocols during their stay in the school campus. The chairman also agreed with the thoughts shared by the Principal .He also reiterated that the parents need to sensitise their children regarding strictly following COVID-19 safety protocols when they are attending offline classes at school. The student achievers of class X and XII Board examinations of session 2019-20 also shared their school life experiences and tips for preparation for Board examination with all the parents. They also unanimously emphasized upon the importance of Teachers In-person guidance before the Board Examination.

The programme ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Mrs Preeti Sharma, HOD English.






