8. ONLINE WEBINAR ON THE TOPIC MISCONCEPTIONS IN NEWTONS LAWS OF MOTION

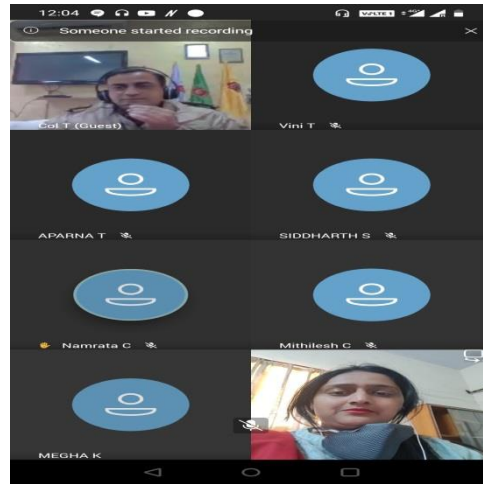

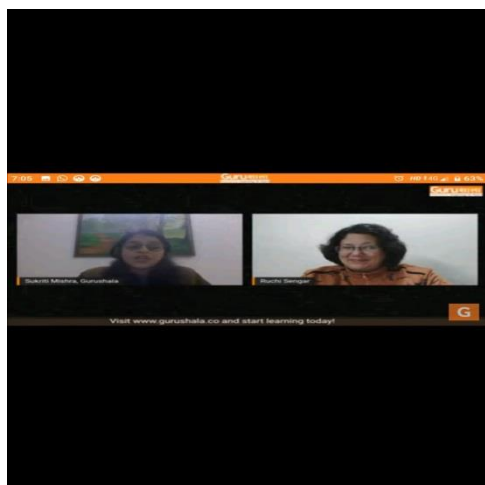

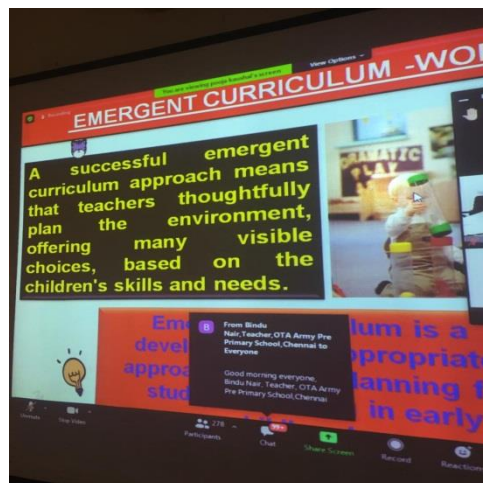
