3. **ONLINE WEBINAR FATHER OF THE NATION**

A webinar was attended by the students of class XII A, B & C at 10:30 a.m. on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2021. The topic was **“Mohan to Mahatma”**. HAV. Mr. Vaibhav Patil apprised the students about the great qualities of Mahatma Gandhi's personality and his great contribution to the nation. He motivated the students to read Mahatma Gandhi's autobiography **“My Experiments with Truth”** and the book written by him **“Hind Swaraj”**. Students were enriched with a lot of knowledge about the prominent Satyagrahas (Champaran, 1916, Kheda, 1917 and Ahmedabad, 1918) and the famous movements (Non-cooperation Movement, 1920-22, Civil Disobedience Movement, 1930 and Quit India Movement, 1942). They also understood the values of non-violence and patriotism. They learnt about the pious qualities of Mohan Das Karamchand Gandhi's character. Rabindranath Tagore adorned him with the title of 'Mahatma' because of his truthfulness and forgiveness. Students learnt that there should be truth in

thought, truth in speech and truth in action. Overall the webinar was motivating, interactive and informative.

5. **E-WORKSHOP ON INCLUSIVE EDUCATION**

An insightful and enriching two days remote on 15-16 March 2021 workshop was organised by NIEPVD in association with AWES with on Microsoft Team platform on "**Inclusive Education**" on 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> March 2021, CPW Mrs Chandrakala, Special Educator Mrs Swati S Bhambore, Academic supervisor class 1 & 2 Mrs Renu Tomar, and TGT Mrs Suman Sharma became the part of this learning experience in order to develop in depth understanding about Inclusion and understand the **Educational Rights of Persons with Disabilities** To further develop a culture of Inclusion and Equity Based Education for Children with Special Needs within the Army Public School Gwalior umbrella. The programme commenced with inaugural address by Patrons –Dr. Himangshu Das (Director, NIEPVD) and Maj. Gen R K Raina (SM, Ph.D MD ,AWES) focusing on the need of the hour to provide equal opportunities to the students with disabilities. The workshop was power packed with all necessary information imparted by the assigned dignified and experienced working professionals in the disability sector. The topics focused ,elaborated and discussed were – Educational Rights of persons with disabilities ,Learning through facilitating inclusive classroom , Need for identification and Assessment of students with disabilities, Addressing barriers of inclusive education, Assistive technology for students with disabilities, Advocacy for inclusion and Role of School Stakeholders and Role of inclusive education in their empowerment. The workshop culminated with discussion, assessment and evaluation on the aforementioned topics. It ignited the minds of participants with many vivid thoughts to create and nurture a revolutionary inclusive society utilizing the power of education.

6. **ONLINE WORKSHOP ON MISBEHAVIOR**

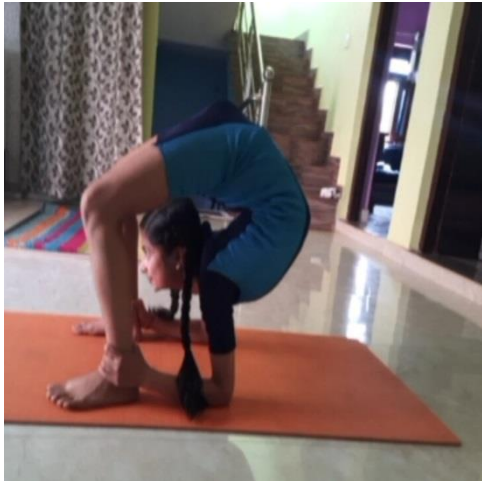
10. **ONLINE E- WORKSHOP ASSESSMENT OF CO- SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES**
