(G) WEBINAR 10 : APPS RESTRUCTURED CURRICULUM PROGRESS AND FOLLOWUP

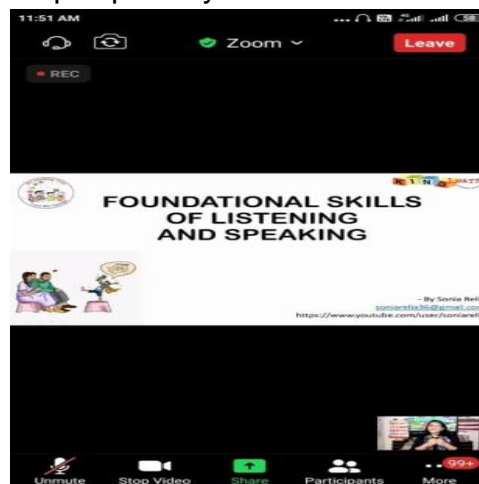

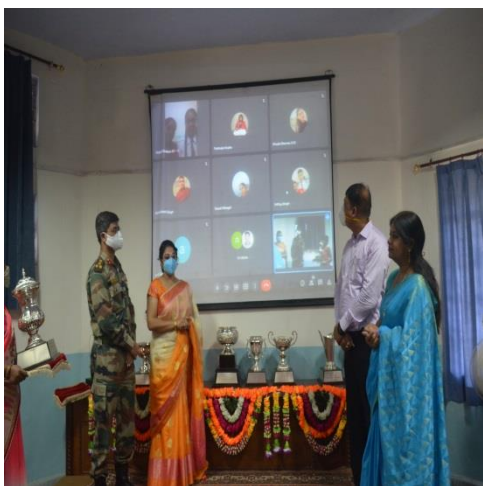
