
(B) HINDI AND ENGLISH INTER CLASS LEVEL DEBATE COMPETITION


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(D) ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION




(F) GUEST LECTURE ON KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS





The sessions were focused on specific disabilities; the resource persons clarified all doubts of participant teachers throughout the sessions.








