# (C) ACADEMIC CONFERENCE WITH CHAIRMAN

An Academic Conference was held at school in online mode on 24th January 2022. Brig. Sandeep Verma, Chairman Army Public School Gwalior presided over the conference. 


# (I) ONLINE PARENT PSYCHO EDUCATIONAL SESSIONS BY STUDENT COUNSELLOR


# **WEBINARS/ WORKSHOPS FOR FACULTY ENRICHMENT**

# (A) FDRC WEBINAR - 44 TEACHING POLITICAL SCIENCE AT PGT LEVEL

An online FDRC Workshop for PGT Political Science on 24th, 25th, 27th and 28th January was attended by PGT History Mrs Sunita Bhadauria from Army Public School Gwalior

The with opening address bv MD AWES session started the given Maj Gen R K Raina. Dr. R S Panwar Addl. Dir. Academics explained the subject specific demands as per NCERT & NEP-2020. The resource person Prof. Saroj Yadav a Faculty from NCERT emphasized on the Holistic development of students and strategies to make students physically, mentally, emotionally, socially & spiritually healthy. A session on 'Inclusive Education' taken by Dr. Bhawana Taragi. She emphasized on adapting various multi sensorial teaching methodologies in teaching to make conceptual understanding accessible to all students with different Learning Styles. Relevant usage of various methods like- audio visual aids(ppts, videos, documentaries, YouTube links etc, Debate, Discussion, Flipped classes, Quizzes, Mock Parliament, Peer teaching, Sketch noting etc can make teaching more interesting in classes IX to XII. Further students must be trained to use Concept map, Mind map, Flow Charts, Graphical presentations, Pictorial methods etc this will benefit all learners specially to slow learners and average students. The typology of questions must be based on Bloom's Taxonomy. In his concluding remarks MD AWES reinforced the need to make the teaching process effective, interesting, informative, motivating and inclusive for all students.







The webinar started with the opening address of MD AWES Maj Gen R.K. Raina followed by a session with Addl Dir. (Academics) Dr R.S Panwar. Standardised Learning Management system and salient features of New Education Policy were discussed with the participants. A special focus on the changes introduced by CBSE in the examination pattern of class XII during the session 2021-22 and Question Paper Pattern for Term 2 were elaborated to the participant teachers. The concept of Ludic Language Learning, Experiential Learning, Rubrics for Assessment of Assignments were also discussed in detail. Other interactive sessions included activity based teaching, enhancing communicative abilities of the students through collaborative learning, and strategies for developing writing skills. The participants from the schools of Southern, Eastern, Central, Northern and Western Command shared their lesson plans of teaching English in classes IX to XII. The webinar concluded with the closing remarks of Addl. Dir. (Academics) Dr R.S. Panwar.

The webinar updated the participant educators to mould themselves as per the demand of the new assessment pattern.






The need to bring harmony across APS's implementation of inclusive education programmes was highlighted through this workshop.





The workshop further broadened the perspective of School Counsellors to become the positive change makers in school ecosystem.





Finally, the resource persons appreciated the presentation of all participant Principals and asked them to implement APP in their respective schools.




