# **ACTIVITIES OF THE STUDENTS**

### (A) HUNDRED DAYS READING CAMPAIGN:

Ministry of Education has intimated the launch of 100 days Reading Campaign on 01 January 2022 for the children studying in Balvatika to class VIII. Reading is one of the good habits that can be cultivated among children since childhood. Reading helps the children to score well in academics. In order to promote Reading Habits among students, APS Gwalior planned various activities in classes I to VIII in their holiday assignments. In the Junior Wing, Reading Comprehension Worksheets were provided to the students; story books were provided and the students were told to share the video of any story told by them in their own words. The senior students were assigned Reading Comprehension Projects. Some books were suggested to them for reading. They would choose any two books and answer the questions related to the story. They were asked to read the story books of their choice and tell the stories to their siblings. This campaign was quite successful in ensuring the mental wellness of students. The campaign boosted their confidence, improved their vocabulary and developed their communication skills.

#### (B) ETHICS BOWL COMPETITION CLUSTER 03

AWWA Ethics bowl competition was held in 5 Clusters of APSs under HQ Sth. Comd. APS Saugor hosted the online competition of Cluster 03 and shared the Rules and regulations and SOP (containing sample case study cases) in advance with the cluster schools. On 01 June 22, a dry run for Ethics Bowl competition was held in virtual mode. Sequence of the teams was decided by means of draw of lots and rules and regulations were explained to the students. Ethics Bowl Competition was conducted in 3 phases:

Phase -1 League match, Phase-2 Semi Final, Phase-3 Final.

One day prior to league match, 2 case studies were provided to each team. The main case study was provided an hour before on the day of competition.

On 04 June, 3 league matches were conducted between six teams. APS Gwalior had a match with APS Jhansi, APS Kamptee had a match with APS Bhopal and APS Babina had a match with APS Saugor. In League match APS Gwalior got rank Second, APS Saugor got rank first and APS Bhopal was at the third position and reached in the semi-final round. Team participants from APS Gwalior were Master Sumit Singh Class XII, Master Sankalp Singh Class X, Ms Abhilasha Class X and Ms Saloni Class X. Mrs. Sunita Bhadoria (HOD Social Science) was the in-charge of the competition from APS Gwalior.

One day prior to Semi-final Round, sequence of the teams was decided and cases were distributed. Team 1 was APS Gwalior, Team 2 was APS Saugor, Team 3 was APS Bhopal. First match took place between Team 1 and Team 2, Second Match took place between Team 3 and Team 1 and third match took place between Team 3 and Team 2. APS Saugor scored 313 marks and APS Gwalior scored 298 marks and reached the Final. Final match took place on 08 June. 2 case studies were provided to each team one day back. Both the teams were well prepared and did proper research on the topics. In the Final Match APS Saugor got first rank (score 157.5 points) and APS Gwalior was at the second position (score 150.00 points) and won the Runners-Up Trophy. The competition aimed at developing good understanding of the legal and social cases amongst the students, their reasoning power to prove any point right or wrong by presenting evidences and applying ethical codes. The event enabled the students to become strongly conscious about the pros and cons of any social, political or legal issue and learnt the skills of applying ethical codes to decide their viewpoint. They could understand how to apply their reasoning skills to comment upon any ethical issue or problem.



Mrs. Bhawna Taragi from FDRC Delhi initiated the workshop with a general address to all the participants. Mrs. Anita Kurup in-charge of the programme for gifted learners explained the concept of the gifted children to all participants. She further told about how to segregate the gifted children within each class and what are the basic indicators. She focused on the changing learning needs of gifted children and guided all about the ways to address them. She spoke about the need to deal with the gifted learners separately by creating Advanced Learning Centers within each school so as to focus upon each child and thereby inspire them to do better as per their special ad gifted talents, as these children are not duly noticed and taken care of till date. 

# (A) FDRC <u>FOUNDATIONAL LEVEL INCLUSIVE WORKSHOP NO 07/22-23 FOR HEAD MISTRESS PRIMARY WING</u>

Workshop No 07/21-23 was organized at HQ FDRC, Shankar Vihar New Delhi on the topic of 'Foundational Level Inclusion' from 30 May – 03 June 2022. The workshop was attended by the Academic Supervisor, Miss Neelima Tomar. Various resource persons on different topics took the sessions and shared their knowledge and experiences.

The main focus was on FLN (Foundation Literacy and Numeracy), Mission NIPUN Bharat. The participants were told about the aim of FLN Mission that every child in the country must attain foundational literacy and numeracy by the end of Grade-III, and not later than Grade-V, by 2025. The participants were guided about the role of teacher in FLN mission and the importance of an inclusive classroom by incorporating play, discovery, and activity-based pedagogies, linking to the daily life situations of children and formal inclusion of children's home languages.








#### (B) WEBINAR ON WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY-
