

(A) ONLINE WEBINAR ON, 'INTRODUCTION TO NCF FOUNDATIONAL STAGE

Mrs.Nisha Bhadoria PRT, Army Public School Gwalior, participated in an online Webinar on, 'Introduction to NCF Foundational Stage'from 20 to 24 February 2023. The webinar started with an opening address by MD AWES Major General RK Raina. The other sessions were taken by Mrs Shyda Rana, Dr Pratibha Garg, Mrs Neeru Reddy, Mrs Vimla Balraj , Mrs Mamta Singh, Mrs Ancy James, Dr Bhawana Taragi, Ms Anchima Hazarika, Dr Deepti Prabhakar on NCF for Foundational Stage and its different topics elaborating, explaining and making it comprehensible in an easy way. STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMME AT APS

(C) SAFAL PILOT FOR GRADES V &VIII

As per the NEP 2020, SAFAL, a competency-based assessment to assess student learning out comes on the core competencies, has been planned by CBSE to provide the diagnostic data and insights to each school for promoting development of students. To ensure the same, Army Public School Gwalior had shown its consent to conduct the CBSE SAFAL Pilot for grades V and VIII by registering the near about full strength of grade V and VIII by 12 December 2022. It had been conducted digitally as per the schedule and batch list (i.e from 8th to 15th February in five batches for class VIII(162 students) and from 16 to 23 February in three batches for class V (111students) informed by CBSE. The core subjects selected for the competency test were language (English), Mathematics and Science / Proper Orientation about SAFAL had been provided to the Environmental Studies. teachers, parents and students by workshops, orientations and sharing PPT explaining step wise procedure for CBT based SAFAL. The nature and rule of the exam were also being discussed in the classes. The responses were submitted digitally. Along with the students, the subject teachers and school had also filled the background questionnaire links shared by the CBSE. Overall it was a fantastic experience for the students and teachers and helped the school in evaluating the level of students in specific learning domains.


(H) ONLINE WORKSHOP ON EMERGING TRENDS IN COMPUTER SCIENCE
