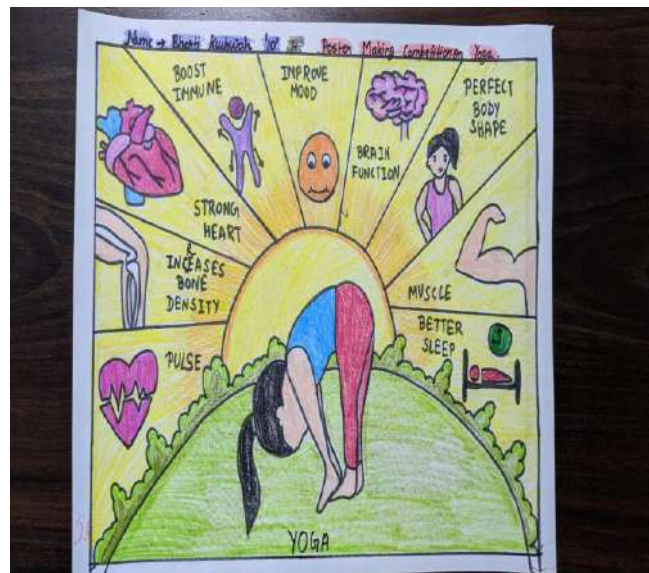
## POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

## **SESSIONS ON BULLYING AND PROXEMICS**

Army Public School Gwalior conducted the sessions on "Bullying and Proxemics" on 14 April 23 and 24 April 23. The sessions were conducted for the students of class VIII by Ms Aishwarya Maheshwari, Student Counselor APS Gwalior. She explained that bullying takes place in different shapes and forms and can mutilate the personality of a child. Though there are different degrees of bullying, every kid is unique and has his own way of responding to these situations. That is why it is important for students to understand bullying and its impact. Bullying can start with something as simple as teasing. It may not always seem like it, but the person who is bullying others may need just as much help as the person who is being bullied. By taking out the time to understand their situation, one may be able to prevent some very serious negative outcomes down the road. The counselor further told that cyber bullying has added another dimension to the problems for the parents and teachers to worry about. Cyber bullying can occur in private spaces such as text messaging or social media. Cyber bullying can be addressed by having an open dialogue around social media and setting rules and limits. The students were made aware about the cyber laws. The students were then enlightened about the proxemics as well as how to report bullying if they are a witness of any such case and not to be a part of any such activity. They were taught to be sensitive towards their peers and respect them as an individual. The queries of the students were addressed by the student counselor at the end of the session.

### **JALLIANWALA BAGH ACTIVITY**

Army Public School Gwalior organized various activities on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2023 in the classes VI to XII to commemorate the centenary of Jallianwala Bagh Massacre. The students of Classes VI to XII participated very enthusiastically in the activities i.e. slogan writing, poster making, role play, poem recitation, speech, quiz competitions, power point presentations. The students came to know about the causes and consequences of Jallianwala Bagh Episode by participating in the above activities. The students tried to imagine the picture of the brutal act occurred at Jallianwala Bagh, Amritsar, Punjab. They came to know how the British Troops brutally killed more than 1000 innocent people including old, young, women and children on the order of Colonel Reginald Edward Harry Dyer in Amritsar (Punjab) at Jallianwala Bagh on 13<sup>th</sup> April, 1919.

Furthermore they came to know about the sacrifices of Dr. Saif-ud-Din Kitchlew, a muslim lawyer and Dr. Satyapal, a Hindu who were arrested under Rowlatt Act 1919. People gathered there for a peaceful protest against these two nationalists' imprisonment and some people came to enjoy the fair held in honour of the Sikhs' new year 'Baisakhi'. The garden was an enclosed space with only one exit which made it difficult for the victims to escape out of the place. Bullet marks on the walls can be seen today also. This site in Amritsar is now a national monument and a national heritage site. By participating in these activities, hearts of the students were filled with the feeling of patriotism and they also realized the value that our Indian History holds and sacrifices made by our freedom fighters. All Indians salute the martyrdom of these great heroes with great pride and respect.

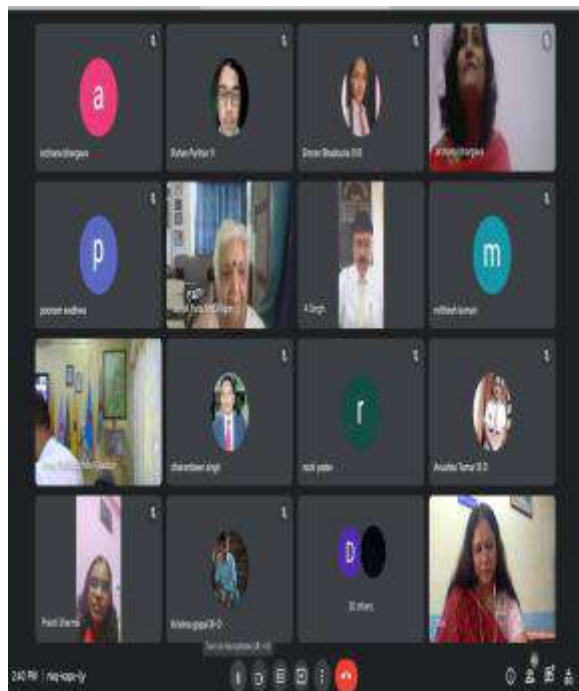


## **GUEST LECTURE ON “WORLD BOOK DAY”**

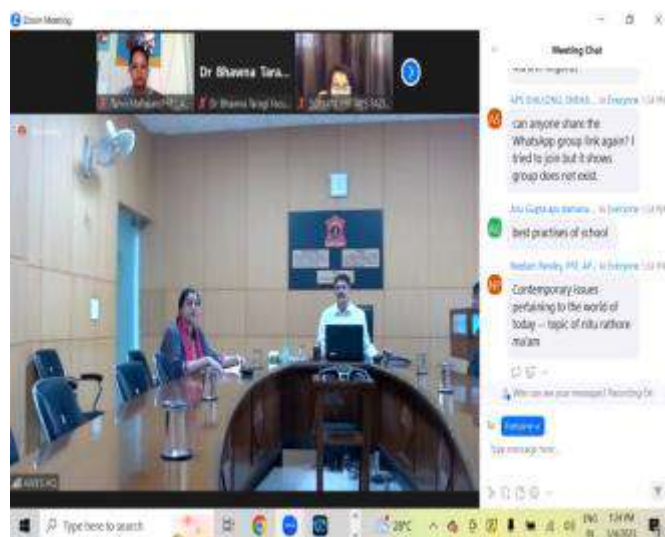




## **WEBINAR NO.2 MIDDLE AND SECONDARY STAGE PEDAGOGY**

## **ETHICS BOWL COMPETITION-2023**

Cluster Level Ethics Bowl Competition-2023 was organized by APS Bhopal in virtual mode (Google Meet) on **26-29 April 2023 at 0900hrs**. The participant schools were Team 1 APS Bhopal, Team 2 APSJhansi, Team 3 APS Saugor, Team 4 APS Gwalior, and Team 5 APS Babina. The organiser, APS Bhopal invited each participant school to forward the names of two judges with their introduction details and one moderator. The judges from APS Gwalior were Mrs Sunita Gupta, Principal Kendriya Vidyalaya and Dr Nazneen Khan, Former Assistant Professor, Prince Sattam Bin Abdul Aziz University, Saudi Arabia. The moderator was Mrs Neelu Dixit, PRT APS Gwalior. The Judges from APS Gwalior judged Match I and Match II held on 26 and 27 April, between Team 2 vs Team 3 and Team 1 vs Team 3 respectively. The moderator from APS Gwalior moderated Match II on 27 April 23 between Team 1 vs Team 3 and on 28 April 23 between Team 3 vs Team 5. Topic of the Case Study for discussion was given by the organiser 18 hours prior to the conduct of the competition. Each team consisted of four members (representative of both the gender mandatory) + 2 reserve members. The speakers had the flexibility to speak either in Hindi or English. In a team, 2 could speak in English and 2 in Hindi. Speaking Hinglish was not allowed. League matches were held on 26, 27 and 28 April between 5 teams wherein the format was ROUND ROBIN i.e., each team competed with every other team. The teams were judged on the basis of rubrics provided to the judges. The rubrics of the competition: PART 1 Did the presentation clearly and systematically address the moderators' questions? Were the central ethical and moral dimensions of case clearly and thoroughly discussed? Did the presentation indicate awareness and thoughtful consideration of different and conflicting viewpoints? PART 2 Response Team's Commentary on opposite team presentation, to what extent has the responding team addressed and engaged with the position of the presenting team? PART 3 presenting Team's Response, how did the presenting team respond to the opposing team's commentary? PART 4 response towards Judges' questions, Judges to ask maximum 2 questions per team, did teams engage in respectful dialogue? The best two teams of League Match moved to the finals.

### **EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO AIRFORCE STATION MAHARAJPURA**

The students of Army Public School Gwalior went on an Education Visit to Air Force Station, Maharajpura, Gwalior (AFSG) on 04 May 2023. There were 102 NCC Cadets from classes IX to XII and a team of three teachers ie. Mrs. Mamta Naruka (PGT Economics), Mrs. P. Indu Rao (ANO) and Mr.Manoj Bhadouria (PTI). The aim of the excursion trip was to let students behold the spectacular sight of the Fighter Planes and Helicopters in operational condition It was a great opportunity for the students to visit one of the most important places in Gwalior (AFSG) known for its operations and strikes all over India. The first glance at (AFSG) was of the landing of Mirage 2000 and MIG 29. Then students visited Air Traffic Control (ATC) where all the aircrafts, fighter jets have complete access to ground. After that they went to Squadron 1 (Tiger) which is aircrafts home, where aircrafts get reassembled for flights and had a close look to Mirage 2000. The last destination was Squadron 3 (ADROITS) where students saw OSA AKM which is the missile system in Air defence. It is a Radar Combat System with a capacity to detect the target and attack with its six supersonic cruise missiles. The officers present there explained about the technique of the weapons/Aircrafts present there. The students were fascinated to observe the aircrafts, fighter planes and other weapons and related their theoretical knowledge with the practical knowledge. These visits help in bringing awareness about the new techniques in defence weapons and in developing the feeling of pride on their country.
