DIGITAL PRESENTATION ON “DECENT WORK AND ECONOMIC GROWTH”

NCC unit of APS Gwalior organized a digital presentation on 6 September 23 in conference room. NCC cadets of Army Public School made a digital presentation on “Decent Work and Economic Growth”. Total 20 NCC cadets prepared the presentation and presented own views and explained its importance. They told that promoting decent work and economic growth is essential for achieving sustainable development. Decent work refers to opportunities for work that are productive and deliver a fair income, security in the workplace, and social protection for workers and their families.

The four pillars of the 'Decent Work Agenda' of the International Labour Organization (ILO) – employment creation, social protection, rights at work, and social dialogue. Economic growth is an increase in the capacity of an economy to produce goods and services, compared from one period of time to another. It can be measured in nominal or real terms, the latter of which is adjusted for inflation. The presentation was successful in imparting knowledge about decent work and economic growth by creating awareness.

- Some 100 million workers lived in extreme or moderate poverty in 2019, with less than \$1.65 per day.

- 85 MILLION workers make-up less than one per cent of the global labour force (85 million compared to 95 million).
