INDIAN ARMY QUIZ “BATTLE OF MINDS”

To commemorate 25 years of the historic Kargil Victory, the Indian Army organized Indian Army Quiz 2023 “Battle of Minds”. The Quiz was conducted by Army Welfare Education Society, Known as “Battle of Minds”. It garnered national attention as ‘32,441’ schools, nationwide signed up for online Round-I and almost a whopping 3600 schools moved on Level-2(Round-II). Thereafter, only 216 educational institutions nationwide advanced to Quarter Final offline Round.

After qualifying First and Second Online Rounds Army Public School Gwalior Team (Jagrati Sharma-XE, Manu Sharma-XE, Manmohan Singh –XD and Kumari Kirti- XD (Extra) became the part of 216 selected teams and reached to Quarter Final offline Round. The Quarter Final Round was held in Meerut at “Ram Auditorium” on 20 November 2023. There was a competition between 14 teams which came from different places and Army public School was one among the 6 qualified teams which reached the Semi Final. Each selected team for Semi Final was awarded with mementos and certificates by Major General V Parida. The Quiz Master of the Quarter Final competition at Meerut was Mr. Akul. The Semi Final of the event for Central Command was conducted at the Indian Military Academy (IMA) Dehradun in the backdrop of the historic Chetwode Building on 23 November 2023 in which 16 teams of various prestigious schools of different places (including Army Public School) participated. 16 teams were divided into 3 groups after the Written Preliminary Round on the basis of merit. The team of APS Gwalior was the part of first group where the best five teams fought the Battle of Minds. In this round APS Gwalior team got the third position.

In Semi Final Round Team APS Gwalior was awarded with cash prize of Rs. 85,000/-, tablets, certificates and many other prizes. The school was awarded with Cash Prize of Rs.50,000/-. All these awards were given to each team by the Chief Guest Lieutenant General VK Mishra, Commandant, IMA. This significant event, themed around the valour and sacrifice exhibited during Kargil War aimed to honour the bravery of Armed Forces and their unwavering commitment to the nation. The event was also graced by living legends and many war heroes who took part in the Kargil War. Several Gallantry Award Winners also came to witness the event, and also a large number of cadets of IMA Dehradun. The Mentor of the team APS Gwalior was Mrs. Sunita Bhadauria (PGT History).

APS Gwalior’s adopted School (Vidyanjali) ‘Govt. Middle School, Cantonment Morar, team (Nirmala-VI, Ajay-VII, and Shyamsunder-VIII) after qualifying First and Second Online Rounds became the part of 216 selected teams which reached to Quarter Final offline Round. The Quarter Final Round was held in Meerut at “Ram Auditorium” on 20 November 2023. There was the competition between 14 teams, came from different places.

Each Participating team for Quarter Final was awarded with a memento, Cash Prize of Rs. 6,750/- and certificates by Chairman Brigadier Rajeev Kumar of Meerut and Brigadier Ranbeer Singh ‘ABSM Veer Chakra’.
