CBSE HERITAGE QUIZ INDIA 2023

CBSE Heritage India Quiz has established itself as the bench mark for PAN -India Inter School Quiz competitions over the years. The Cluster Round was held at Sanmati Hr. Sec. School, Indore, Madhya Pradesh on December 13, 2023. Teams from 30 schools of Bhopal- Indore region participated enthusiastically, showcasing their knowledge and passion. The quiz was conducted by the esteemed quiz master Mr. Bhushan Patel. There were two stages in this round. In the first stage (Premilinary Round) 30 questions were to be answered in a written format. After qualifying in itthe top 6 teams reached in the second round in which a variety of heritage topics were included. The team Aps Gwalior competed in all four rounds and got III position. This event served as a crucial selection platform in identifying bright and

enthusiastic participants from CBSE schools across India. The quiz competition has sparked a keen interest among students, encouraging them to explore India's rich history, culture, and significant global contributions. 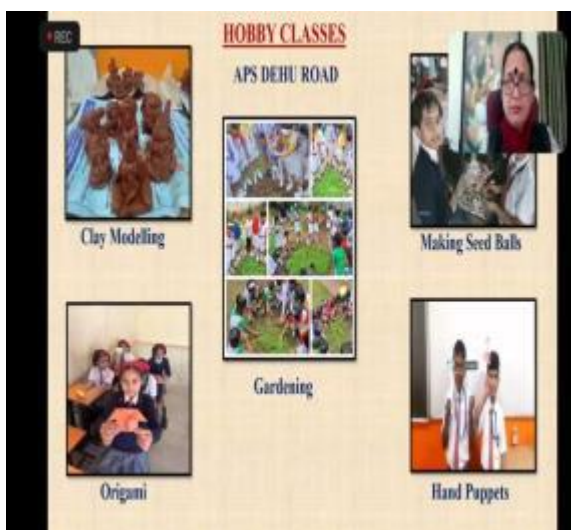


INTERACTION OF APS ALUMNI WITH NDA ASPIRANTS

SCIENCE CLUB EXPERIMENT (WATER FILTRATION)

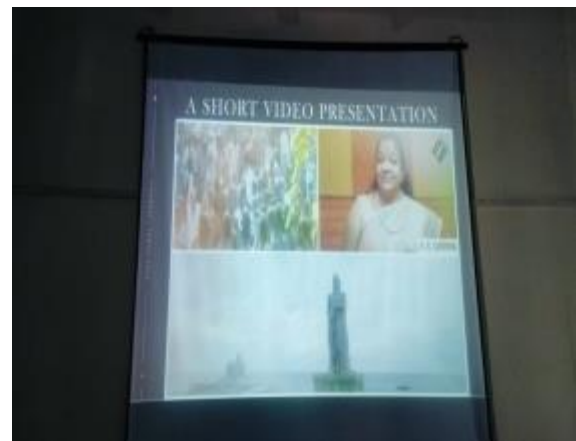
ELECTRO LITERACY CLUB ACTIVITY
