




EDUCATOR'S SESSION – CAPTURING STUDENT LEARNING WITH WEBSITES, WHITEBOARDS AND DIGITAL PORTFOLIOS ON CANVA

A webinar was organized by CBSE for the educators on 12 March 24, titled "Educators' Session -Capturing Student Learning with Websites, Whiteboards, and Digital Portfolios on Canva". It was hosted by Canva with the aim to explore the features of Canva. Mr Vikesh Shakya, TGT Computer . APS Gwalior attended the webinar. Mrs Annapoorni Chandrashekar was the resource person of the webinar. She imparted knowledge about creating student learning portfolios and websites for class projects. She shared tips on using Canva tools for student learning, including whiteboards. websites, and digital portfolios. The presenters demonstrated the procedure of creating digital portfolios to track student progress and achievements, showcase learning journeys, and enhance the skill to make digital resumes for vocational purpose. Canva's whiteboard feature was also discussed for capturing student learning, facilitating group work, and enabling real-time collaboration with tools like timers and quick flow shapes. Educators are encouraged to engage with Canva's educational tools to enhance student's creativity, collaboration, and presentation skills both in and out of the classroom. In the "Educators' Session 3 with Canva," the speaker discussed using Canva to create student learning portfolios and websites for class projects. Websites can be easily created using templates, allowing students to showcase their work beyond the classroom. Educators were encouraged to create digital portfolios or resumes using Canva and share their creations within 48 hours. It was told that Canva's Educational Account is free, and the community offers resources for sharing ideas and feedback. The session covered creating infographics, lesson plans, and sharing assignments in Google Classroom. Technical issues were addressed, and attendees were encouraged to check recorded sessions for further learning. The webinar concluded with a dynamic Q&A session, where participants engaged themselves with the speakers to explore further insights. The session ended with gratitude from attendees for the opportunity to learn about Canva's capabilities.







