PHYSICAL WORKSHOP SERIAL NO 01/24-25 AND 02/24-25

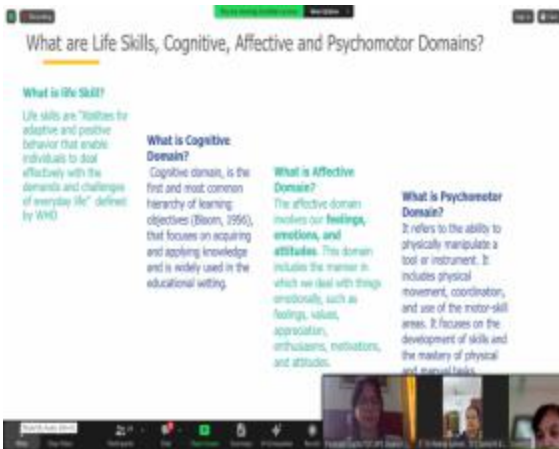
