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# ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOL GWALIOR (MP) FWO MONTHLY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 2024

#### **SOUTHERN COMMAND AWWA ETHICS BOWL COMPETITION 24-25**

APS Gwalior participated in the Knockout Matches of Southern Command Level Ethics Bowl Competition on 19 June 24 & 20 June 24. APS Gwalior stands in Cluster 8 along with APS Nasirabad, APS ASC c & C Banglore, APS MICS. On 19 June 2024 APS Gwalior. Master Satender Bhadoriya, XII C, Master Vinamra Sharma, XII B, Master Ishaan Singh, XII A, Miss saloni Tomar, XIIA were the speakers and Master Kapil Pal, XII A, Master Ajay Singh, XII C were the researchers. The host school was APS Bangalore. The first round took place from 8.30 am to 10.30 am. APS Nasirabad presented the case study "Phenotypic Prometheus". APS Gwalior conferred and did commentary and asked the question from them. APS Gwalior presented the case "Trading Dilemma" and APS Nasirabad conferred the case, did commentary and later asked a question. The judges of the programme were Dr Pushpa Menon, Phd, M. A English Literature & Dr Linu M. K, PhD, M. A, English Literature. Judges asked the questions to the teams related to their cases and got the replies. The students delved deep into the cases, drafted their speeches and prepared notes after doing an exhaustive research on the given topics and overcoming the ethical dilemma under the guidance of their mentors. APS Gwalior scored 81/100 and defeated the team Nasirabad with a difference of 20 marks.

The second Knockout Match took place between APS Bangalore and APS Gwalior on 20 June 2024 from 12300 hrs to 14300 hrs. APS Gwalior presented the case "Matrilineal Communities in India". Team APS Bangalore conferred and did commentary. APS Bangalore presented the case study of Ethics of Extreme Wealth" and Team APS Gwalior conferred, did commentary and asked question. Judges also asked their questions and gave their feedback on the performance of both the teams before the declaration of the result. The judges of the competition were Mr Deepak Gour, Vice Air Chief Marshal, AVSM and Mr Tasnar K, IT. Team Aps Gwalior scored 82/100 and defeated APS Bangalore with a difference of 3 marks.

Match 1 of Quarter Final took place on 25 June 24 from 8.00 am to 11.30 am. It was organised by APS Kirkee. The match took place between Team 3 (APS Gwalior) & Team 4 (APS Trivendrum). Team 3 presented the case study "The Social Network" and Team 6 presented the

case study "Regulations on Social Media". The moderator of the programme was Mrs Rajni Verma, APS Jhansi. The judges were Mr Hector Andrade, author, Dr Nazneen Khan, PGT LAHS Gwalior and Mr Balaji D. Both the teams gave a neck to neck competition to their opponents in research, conferring and answering the questions of their opponent team and the judges. In the Quarter Final Round APS Gwalior scored 125 marks and APS Trivendrum scored 128 marks.

Match 6 of Quarter Final took place on 26 June 24 . The match was hosted by APS Kirkee. The match took place between Team 3 APS Gwalior and Team 8 APS Wellington. Team 3 presented the case study "Freedom of Tweets" and Team 8 presented the case study "Educational Zoos or Moral Taboos?" The judges of the competition were Brigadier S.R Singh, HOD Chinese Language Department Pachmarhi, Indian Military Academy X Chief Instructor, Chief of Army Commendation Card, Mrs Sushma Singh, LLM, Lt. Colonel Leena Bajaj, M Phil Allahbad. Both the teams explored the given topics well and gave a tough competition in presenting their case and replying to the questions . The discussion between judges and the speakers and researchers did fruitful churning of thoughts producing a positive guideline to the stake holders of future.
