FAREWELL CEREMONY OF MR YOGENDRA CHAUHAN , PGT, PE

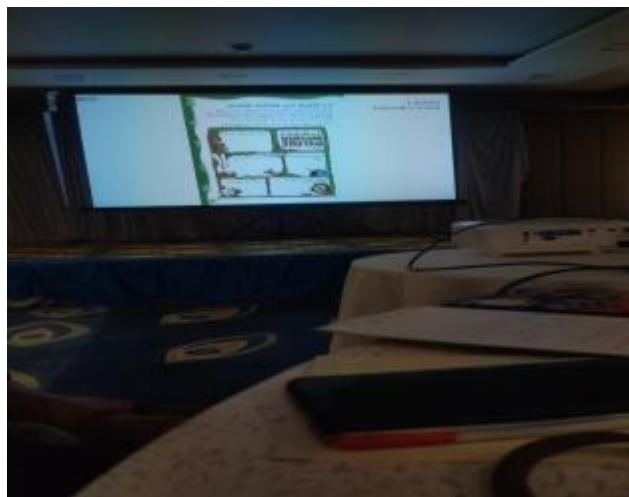

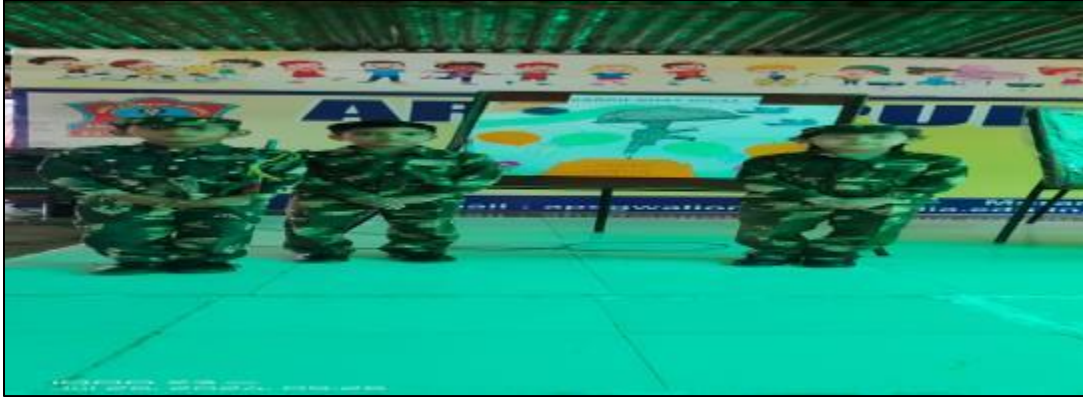

Science Club Activity:

APS Foundational Wing organized “Science Club Activity under the guidance of Headmistress Ms. Jayanti Naidu for the students of Nursery, LKG, and UKG on 02.08.2024 on the following topics.

a) Class Nursery- Show and tell

Teachers of the Nursery wing Ms. Zarina Waheb, Ms.Gunjan Baghel, Ms. Shikha Gurjar and Ms. Debarati Roy coordinated and conducted a “Taste and Tell” activity. In this activity, students experienced different tastes sweet, bitter, sour, and salty. Through this activity, students learned to recognize different tastes and smells. Students were made to taste different things like sugar, chocolate, bitter gourd, lemon, salt, chips, etc. They were also able to give examples of other things with the same taste.

b) Class LKG- Introduction of air and few of its uses.

Teachers of class LKG demonstrated experiments on air thereby making the students understand that air is all around us. Even though we cannot see it has an important role in our daily lives. Students observed what happens when a balloon is blown up and then released. Students shared

their thoughts on where they feel air (eg. Chips packet, football, fan, air cooler, etc.) They gained a basic understanding of air with paper jet-making and flying activities. They also learnt that air is necessary for burning by an experiment showing burning candle puts off on covering it with a glass. They participated actively in all the experiments with lots of inquisitiveness. The activities were demonstrated by Ms. Madhuri Chowdhary and coordinated by Ms. Chitra Devi, Ms. Amruta Gupta, Ms. Kalyani Bhadoria

c) Class UKG- Floating and Sinking Activity

Teachers of Class UKG Ms. Rashmi Chauhan, Ms. Sita Dhakre, Ms. Neetu Singh , Ms. Chaya and Ms.Mamta conducted floating and sinking activities for the students of UKG wing. Students were demonstrated about the concept by paper boat making and floating the boats in the swimming pool. They were explained about the science behind floating boats. They knew about the streamlined shape of the boat which made it float easily in the water. They also took some other objects like pebbles, feathers, plastic balls, etc. to learn the concept of floating and sinking and develop the understanding that some things float in water while some of them sink.

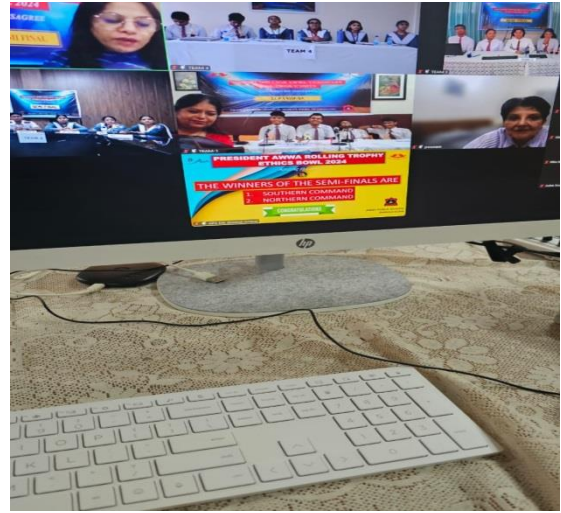


CLUSTER LEVEL HINDI DEBATE COMPETITION
