- II Pre Board** will be conducted from 17 Dec 2020 to 23 Dec 2020, the time slot is as under:

 - X&XII(Descriptive) - 1130hrs to 1330hrs (2hrs)
 - Please read the Date Sheet carefully, that is attached herewith, along with the blue print of the examination.
- Blue Print and Syllabus of the II Pre Board will be exactly same as per CBSE Board guidelines, however the questions based on MCQ/Objective type will be in the form of Google Form and the subjective question will be asked in the form of PDF.**
- Link of the question paper will be provided to the students 15 mins before the commencement of the examination on the day of examination as per the Date Sheet.
- The examination of each subject can be submitted only once. Once the response of the examination is submitted, it cannot be resubmitted.
- Kindly submit **Google Form Question Papers** before the end of examination time, or else you will not be able to submit your exams and the responses of your exams will not be recorded.
- For descriptive-type questions, which cannot be answered by using the keyboard, **File Upload Option** will be provided to students. For answering such questions, the students will take the examination on A-4 size paper or ruled paper or something similar and take the pictures of each page in sequence preferably with Xodo or similar app and convert them into a single PDF file and upload it in the Google Form link 'attachment' section after the entry of their names, classes and sections **as per the guidelines given below in 'Mode of Examination' section.** to upload the PDF file, the students will be required to follow the given steps:
 - Click on File Upload option provided in the Google Form for that question.
 - Option 'Select Files from Your Device' will appear, click on it.
 - Select the file to be uploaded and click on Open option.
 - Click on Upload button at the bottom of the screen.
- Kindly make your mobile phones/laptops charged well before the examination begins to avoid any last minute technical glitch. Further, please do ensure that the required internet speed is available with you for the exams.

As the exams will be conducted online, the parents will be required to stay vigilant and supervise these exams in their respective home environment to complement to the teachers' efforts to maintain objectivity, fairness and prevention of any malpractice during the exams. GENERAL GUIDELINES

CLASS X & XII

1. II Pre Board Examination-2020-2021 of Class X and XII will be conducted in online mode from 17 Dec 2020 to 23 Dec 2020 per the Date Sheet, with timings of e-assessments as mentioned in the Date Sheet. Only Theory Examinations will be conducted as per the CBSE Exam Blue Print. In theory Examination both Objective Based Exam and Descriptive Type Questions Based Examination will be conducted via Google Form as per the mode of examination given below:-

MODE OF EXAMINATION

CLASS X & XII

Examination will be conducted in both MCQ/Objective Type Question Papers and Descriptive Question Papers on same day during different timings as per CBSE Board Examination Blue Print. For Descriptive Question Paper, the students will take the examination on A-4 size paper or ruled paper or something similar and take **the pictures of each page in sequence preferably with Xodo app or similar app and convert them into a single PDF file and upload it in the Google Form link 'attachment' section after the entry of their names, classes and sections.** They will also write their names, class and section at the head of the each page used for taking the descriptive exams. Students will receive the question paper in PDF file at the beginning of the examination in the class group and the Google link for only unloading the PDF of the Answer Sheet at the end of the examination.

II. Multiple Choice questions based on one unseen case-based factual passage with verbal/visual inputs like statistical data, charts, newspaper report etc. Ten out of eleven questions to be done. (10x1=10 Marks)

Note: The combined word limit for both the passages will be 700-750 words.

III. Multiple Choice Questions based on two prose extracts, one each from the books Flamingo and Vistas, to assess comprehension and appreciation. Refer to the lines to answer questions based on the given extract. Any 2 out of 3 extracts to be done. (8x1=8)

IV. Multiple Choice Questions based on a poetry extract from the book Flamingo to assess comprehension, analysis and inference. Refer to the lines to answer questions based on the given extract. Any 1 out of 2 extracts to be done. (4x1=4)

V Text based questions to assess comprehension, analysis, inference and interpretation from the books Flamingo and Vistas. Eight out of ten questions to be done. (8x1=8)

Writing Section: 16 Marks

Q1. Short writing task –Notice/Advertisement up to 50 words. One out of the two given questions to be

answered.

Q2. Short writing task –Formal/Informal Invitation and Reply up to 50 words .One out of the two given questions to be answered. 3 Marks

Q3. Letters based on verbal/visual input, to be answered in approximately 120-150 Words. Letter types include application for a job, Letters to the Editor (giving suggestions or opinion on issues of public interest). One out of the two given questions to be answered. 5 Marks

Q4. Article/ Report Writing, descriptive and analytical in nature, based on verbal inputs, to be answered in 120-150 words. One out of the two given questions to be answered. 5 Marks

Q6. Five Short answer type question, out of six, from Prose and Poetry from the book Flamingo, to be answered in 30-40 words. Questions should elicit inferential responses through critical thinking.(5x2=10)

Q7. Two Short answer type questions ,out of three, from Prose (Vistas), to be answered in 30-40 words. Questions should elicit inferential responses through critical thinking. (2x2=4)

Q 8. One Long answer type question, from Prose/poetry (Flamingo), to be answered in 120-150 words to assess global comprehension and extrapolation beyond the text. Questions to provide evaluative and analytical responses using incidents, events, themes as reference points. Any 1 out of 2 questions to be done (1x5=5)

Q.9 One Long answer type question, based on the chapters from the book Vistas, to be answered in 120-150 words to assess global comprehension and extrapolation beyond the text. Questions to provide evaluative and analytical responses using incidents, events, themes as reference points. Any 1 out of 2 questions to be done. (1x5=5)

- VI. One out of two Long Answer Type Questions from FOOTPRINTS WITHOUT FEET on theme or plot involving interpretation, extrapolation beyond the text and inference or character sketch to be answered in about 100-120 words. 5 marks
