Dear Parents,

1. **The Annual Examination of Class VI to VIII** will be conducted from 22 Feb 2021 to 05 Mar 2021, in the time slots, which are asunder:
 - (a) VI –VIII(Objective) - 1000 hrs to 1100 hrs (1 hrs)
 - (b) VI – VIII(Descriptive) - 1130 hrs to 1330 hrs (2 hrs)
 - (c) Please read the Date Sheet carefully, that is attached herewith, along with the syllabus and blue print of the examination.
2. Link of the question paper will be provided to the students 15 mins before the commencement of the examination on the day of examination as per the DateSheet.
3. The examination of each subject can be submitted only once. Once the response of the examination is submitted, it cannot be resubmitted.
4. Kindly submit **Google Form Question Papers** before the end of examination time, or else you will not be able to submit your exams and the responses of your exams will not be recorded.
5. For descriptive-type questions, which cannot be answered by using the keyboard, **File Upload Option** will be provided to students. For answering such questions, the students will take the examination on A-4 size paper or ruled paper or something similar and take the pictures of each page in sequence preferably with Xodo or similar app and convert them into a single PDF file and upload it in the Google Form link 'attachment' section after the entry of their name, class and section **as per the guidelines given below in 'Mode of Examination' section.** to upload the PDF file, the students will be required to follow the given steps:
 - (a) Click on File Upload option provided in the Google Form for that question.
 - (b) Option 'Select Files from Your Device' will appear, click on it.
 - (c) Select the file to be uploaded and click on Open option.
 - (d) Click on Upload button at the bottom of the screen.

You can also submit the answer script in hardcopy at school within one hour after the exam is over or can mail it or send it by Book Post (if outstation) after a word with the subject teacher.
6. Kindly make your mobile phones/laptops charged well before the examination begins to avoid any last minute technical glitch. Further, please do ensure that the required internet speed is available with you for the exams.

7. As the exams will be conducted online, the parents will be required to stay vigilant and supervise these exams in their respective home environment to complement to the teachers' efforts to maintain objectivity, fairness and prevention of any malpractice during the exams. They will also be required to inform immediately to the subject teacher, supervising/conducting the exams online if any discrepancies are noticed at their end in the question papers.
8. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward(s) prepares for these exams sincerely.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION VI - VIII

1. Annual Examination-2020 of Class VI-VIII will be conducted in online mode from **22 Feb 2021 to 05 Mar 2021** as per the Dates and Timings mentioned in the Date Sheet as per Syllabus and Blue Print **given** below. For Class VI-VIII, Theory Examination both Objective Based Exam and Descriptive Type Questions Based Exam will be conducted via Google Form as per the mode of examination given below.
2. Internal Assessments (Subject Enrichment, Portfolio, Notebook Assessment) will be conducted by subject teachers and from **08 Feb 2021 to 18 Feb 2021** in online mode during the subject periods in the form of online projects, assignments, viva etc.
3. For Grading Subjects like General Knowledge, Computer, Health & Physical Education, Art Education, Work Education and Music will be conducted online as per the Date and Timings mentioned in the Date Sheet. The e-tests will be of **20 marks objective based** online question papers in the form of GoogleForm.

MODE OF EXAMINATION

CLASSVI - VIII

Examination will be conducted in both MCQ/Objective Type Question Papers and Descriptive Question Papers on the same day. 50 percent of the Total Marks of each Question Paper will be MCQ/Objective Type Question Paper and the rest 50 percent of the Total Marks of the Question Paper will be Descriptive Question Paper. (For example, for 80 Marks Question Paper, 40 marks questions will be MCQ/Objective Types and the rest 40 marks questions will be Descriptive Types). For Descriptive Question Paper, the students will take the examination on A-4 size paper or ruled paper or something similar and take **the pictures of each page in sequence preferably with Xodo or similar app and convert them into a single PDF file and upload it in the Google Form link 'attachment' section after the entry of their names, classes and sections.** They will also write their names, class and section at the head of the each page used for taking the descriptive exams. Students will receive the question paper in PDF file at the beginning of the examination in the class group and the Google link for only unloading the PDF of the Answer Sheet at the end of the examination. **They can also submit the answer script in hardcopy at school within one hour after the exam is over or can mail it or send it by Book Post (if outstation) after a word with the subject teacher.**
